Aruma, Malbec Les Domaines Barons de Rothschild, Mendoza	2012	Aruma is again a joint venture between Domaines Baron de Rothschild and Nicolas Catena. Aromas of dark cherries and blackcurrants. Caliterra Reserva, Sauvignon Blanc Casablanca Valley	2015	Pale greenish yellow colour and a very bright Sauvignon Blanc.
